Merchandise: Scholastic sends a variety of books, activity kits, posters, journals, and stationary supplies for purchase. Based on student purchases and restock availability, stock changes daily.

Payment and Purchase Information

Payment Options: Cash or eWallet Preferred. (Checks will be accepted if made out to Noble Crossing PTO.)

Tax: Due to tax-law changes, Scholastic Book Fairs require us to now charge tax on purchases. This means purchases **will** be subject to Indiana's 7% sales tax. Please remind your child to bring an extra dime for every dollar they plan to spend at the Book Fair.

eWallet: This is a cash-free digital account where you can load money for your child to use at the Scholastic Book Fair. Grandparents and other family members can also gift money to your child's eWallet. A new eWallet must be created for each Scholastic Book Fair. You can create an eWallet from our Scholastic Book Fair homepage. Remaining eWallet balances from previous Scholastic Book Fairs have transitioned to Scholastic eGift Cards and can be added to a new eWallet.
